On September 11th, 2001 - the Queens Falcons lost one of its best coaches, motivators and tireless workers, Stephen Hoffman to the World Trade Center tragedy. In honor of Stephen and our dream, the Queens Falcons are sponsoring its 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual charity golf outing on Monday, August 9, at Brookville Country Club in Nassau County, Long Island to raise money for the building fund and our Run to Daylight Education Program. Stephen's dream, as well as the rest of the volunteers of the Queens Falcons, is to have a building near the field where the student athlete's can receive educational guidance through, The Run to Daylight Education Program.

In 1997 Stephen G. Hoffman and Timothy Cavanaugh started The Run to Daylight Education Program. They had the idea of providing the players from the Queens Falcons Football Organization with the opportunity to attend some of the top boarding schools in the northeast as well as local private schools in the New York City Area. The mission of The Run to Daylight Program is to help our inner city young people secure a top quality education not normally available to families of limited financial means. The program concentrates on finding candidates that are not just athletes but good students as well. These student-athletes are matched with schools that can offer a better education than normally provided by the inner city public school system.

Over the past two years we have raised over \$160,000 towards our capital building fund goal of \$2,000,000. The building will serve as the new home for the Queens Falcons RTDEP providing: classrooms, computer labs, tutoring sessions, test preparation classes, high school, prep school and college interviews / open houses, anger and weight management, mentoring for at risk youth, substance abuse counseling, job training, interviewing and networking opportunities, storage and equipment room, video and scout room.

We are proud to announce that eight (8) Queens Falcons RTDEP recipients will be attending some of the most challenging Northeast boarding schools in the upcoming school year. With an average tuition, room & board cost of \$35,000 per year, the RTDEP recipients will be receiving partial and or full financial aid packages. Please visit our website for more details.
